- ◆ Accept treats only in the doorway. Never go inside the house.
- ◆ Be sure to say, "Thank you" for your treats.
- ◆ Don't play near lit jack-o-lanterns.
- ◆ Only visit houses that have the lights on.
- ◆ Walk, do not run.
- ◆ Walk on sidewalks and driveways.
- ◆ Cross the street at the corner or in a crosswalk.
- ◆ Take a cellular phone with you, if possible.
- ◆ Wear a watch.
- ◆ Carry a flashlight with new batteries.

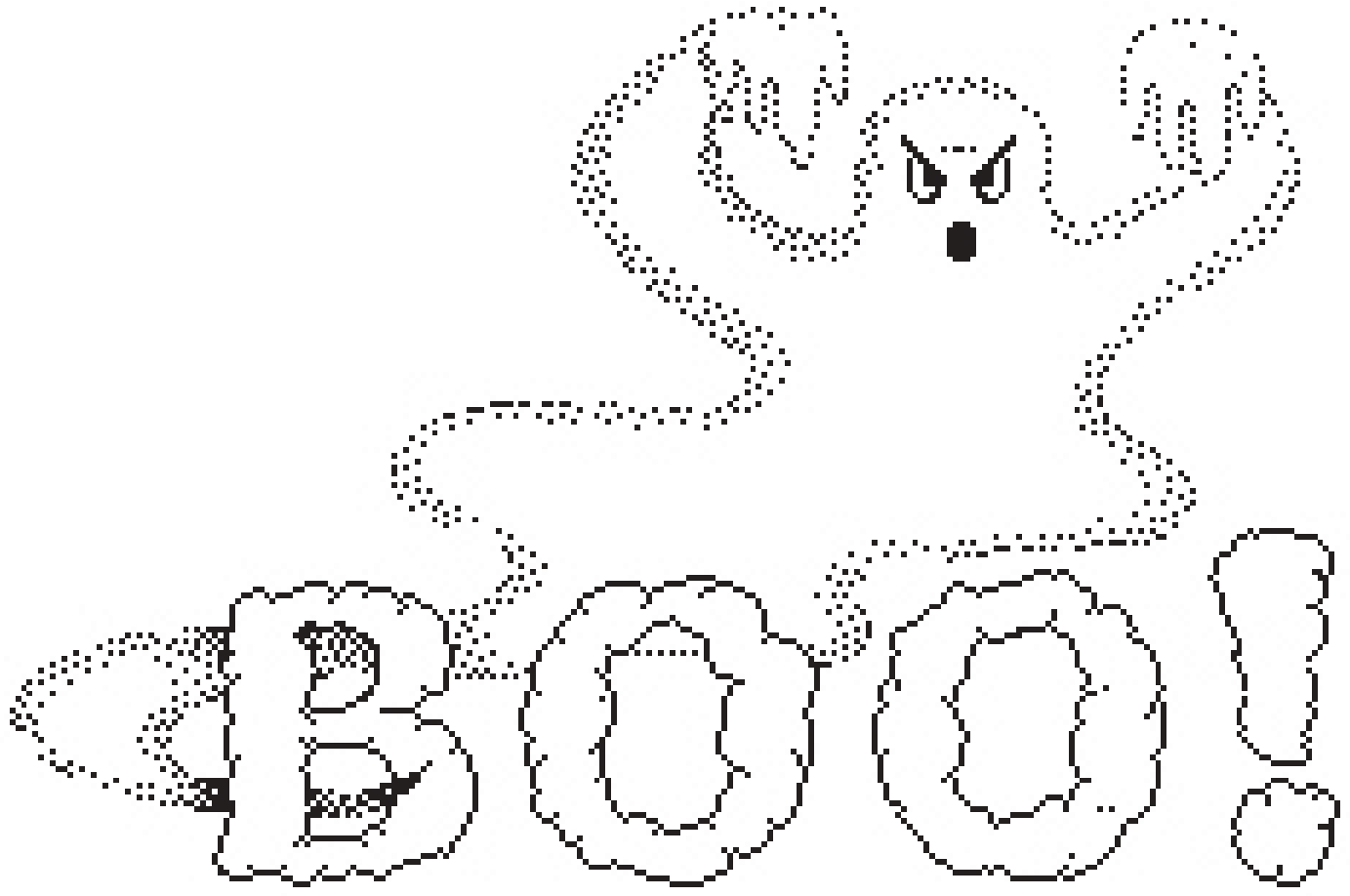
